

*Organizational Minutes Of Board of Directors

Beth emailed a report. The planning for the bingo event is going well. Tickets are available online or in person. Nine tables have been sold so far.


Cindy requested to make a small change to the scholarship application and she gave Tonya the green light to post to our webpage.
